



Charlie Moore: Biography

Since his TV debut on NESN's *Front Row* sports magazine program in 1996, Charlie Moore has become one of the most recognizable outdoorsman in the U.S. as well as a Canadian celebrity – earning top show ratings on ESPN and NESN. He also has a new book -- *The Mad Fisherman* -- a very funny look at his world, released by St. Martin's Press in April, 2008. Charlie, along with Curt Gowdy and Ted Williams, is a member of New England Sports Hall of Fame with an exhibit entitled, "America's Favorite Fishermen: From Curt Gowdy to Ted Williams to Charlie Moore." This exhibit is on display at the Boston Garden.

Charlie's fast-paced, no-holds barred comic hosting style has re-defined outdoor television. From jumping out of airplanes to boxing with the World Heavyweight Champ to kicking footballs with Adam Vinatieri off his bass boat, you never know what Charlie will do next! He is bright, funny and has great range to his talent.

NESN: Front Row Outdoors

The Mad Fisherman, Charlie Moore, has been a fixture on New England Sports Network since October 1995, when NESN's nightly outdoor sports magazine show, *Front Row Outdoors*, debuted. Charlie was hired to host 2-3 minute segments from different New England fishing communities.

NESN: Charlie Moore Outdoors

When *Front Row Outdoors* was cancelled in 1999, Charlie was asked to host a new show, *Charlie Moore Outdoors*. *Charlie Moore Outdoors* was the only show to be picked up for a ½ hour series. Since its debut, *Charlie Moore Outdoors* has established itself as the most successful outdoor program in New England and made Charlie Moore a household name across the region. Charlie's unique, high-energy, and humorous hosting style combined with celebrity guests, outrageous skits, and great fishing have redefined outdoor programming. The success of *Charlie Moore Outdoors* earned the show 12 Emmy nominations and a 2002, 2006 and 2009 New England Emmy Award for "Best Sports Series" as well as 2 Telly Awards and spawned the spin-off program - *Beat Charlie Moore* on ESPN. *Charlie Moore Outdoors* is a NESN Original Production

NESN: *Roughing It*

Charlie hosted this special NESN series in 2005. *Roughing It* was a one hour show that followed Charlie and comedians and athletes through a series of outdoor adventures throughout the Northeast. This was the first original “ONE” (Original NESN Entertainment) show and NESN looked to Charlie to make it a hit.

ESPN: *Beat Charlie Moore*

Beat Charlie Moore just completed its 7th season with ESPN2. *Beat Charlie Moore* was the first outdoor reality show. Dan Bowen, formerly Vice President of Programming for ESPN, was looking for a show that would combine comedy and entertainment with the outdoors. He looked at many people and believed that Charlie was the best choice to accomplish this feat. *Beat Charlie Moore* ranks as one of the most popular outdoor shows of all time for the network. The greatest show on H₂O travels to virtually every state from Texas, to South Carolina, Florida, Virginia, Oklahoma, California, Alabama and New England. The regular time slot for *Beat Charlie Moore* is Saturday mornings on ESPN2. It also airs on Canadian TV. Repeat airings vary by market.

NESN: *NESN Outdoors*

This NESN show covered the outdoors across New England and was hosted by Charlie. NESN aired six half hour episodes per year from 2001 to 2005. Charlie left the show to pursue other projects.

WFN: *Charlie Moore TV*

In 2008, Charlie created the first original TV series for WFN. The show, *Charlie Moore TV* was fishing themed and pure entertainment. This one is not your father’s fishing show! *Charlie Moore TV* aired on WFN and DISH Network.

Paramount Pictures/ Fox Studios: *Mad Fish*

Due to his success with *Charlie Moore Outdoors* and *Beat Charlie Moore*, Charlie was signed to a deal with Paramount pictures to develop a Sitcom, *Mad Fish*. *Mad Fish* was a show about a guy from Boston whose wife was more successful than he was, no matter how hard he tried! The format was similar to Tim Allen’s *Home Improvement*. Charlie shot the pilot. The pilot was bought, but unfortunately, the writer’s strike occurred before it had a chance to air.

TRU TV: *The Codfather*

The Codfather is a Reality show, or a docu-soap, a la "*Gene Simmons Family Jewels*". Charlie will be working on this project with Pilgrim Film and Television Studios which is responsible for such shows as *American Chopper* and *Ghost Hunters*. This show will be airing on Tru TV early in 2011 and will offer up a behind the scenes look at what happens in a day in the life of Charlie Moore. People will be able to see how much fun Charlie's world really is! From his wife Angela to his Mafioso crew of bodyguards, including, Larry "The Geese" Sagesse and Tommy "The Bull" Vaudo, *The Codfather* will take you on a wild ride of fishing, family, fun and a whole lot more!

NBC Sports Network: *Charlie Moore: No Offense*

Charlie Moore: No Offense is currently in production and set to air on Versus in February of 2011. *Charlie Moore – No Offense* is a show about a guy from Boston, MA, who travels throughout the country and will allow a special guest, celebrity or non-celebrity, to come into his world, and in return, Charlie will go into their world. Versus' viewers will be able to log on to versus.com or charliemoore.com and be able to fill out an application on why they would like the loudmouth, brash Bostonian, known as the Mad Fisherman, to come to their hometown, hit their favorite local lake and show Charlie how they break down the lake, how they try to catch fish, and what it is that they do to enjoy an outdoor experience. This show is going to be big personality, very, very funny and also a wish fulfillment show for Versus viewers, for they will have the opportunity to fish with one of the most recognizable names in the entire industry and appear on their very own episode of *Charlie Moore-No Offense* on Versus.
